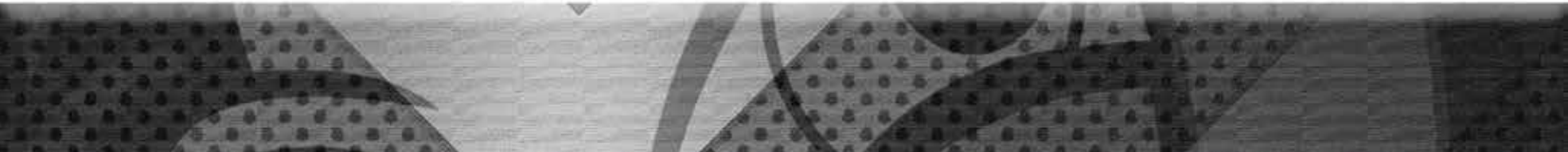
Justice is stepping into the ring for a charity boxing match to support the Long Island Community Chest. All money he raises will be donated back to this

After volunteering at the 2023 Fight for Charity, I was asked if I would like to participate as a boxer in the 2024 event. My response was an enthusiastic "no". Life is good. Getting punched in the face wasn't high on my list of goals for this year. So what was the catalyst to get me from the sidelines to the ring?

The good old mid-life crisis played a role. The fifth time I was asked to participate happened to be the same month as my 49th birthday. As a father of six children - I felt the need to do something that I hoped would inspire them to take action in their own lives, whether now or in the future. The idea that it is never too late in life to challenge yourself, step in to the ring and do something big. And like Rocky Balboa said, "it ain't how hard you hit... it's how hard you can get hit and keep moving forward."

But the biggest reason is my friend Jonas. LT Jonas M. Panik, USNR, was my Naval Academy classmate and teammate. He was working as a naval intelligence officer at the Pentagon, and was killed in the terrorist attacks of September 11th, 2001. He was 26 years old on 9/11. Not a day goes by I don't think of my friend. Jonas would never back down from a challenge, and his courage is exemplary of so many of the men and women in our Armed Forces. I fight to honor the memory of my good friend Jonas, and all who have ever put on the uniform to protect our way of life.

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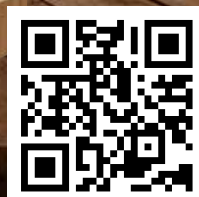
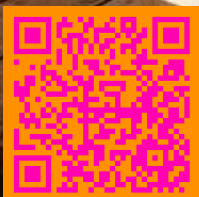

Theodore received his bachelor's degree in international marketing from The University of Texas at San Antonio. He currently resides in Fresh Meadow Queens with his family.

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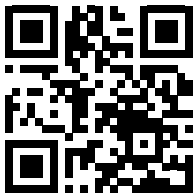


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Zachary “The Zach Attack” Merritt

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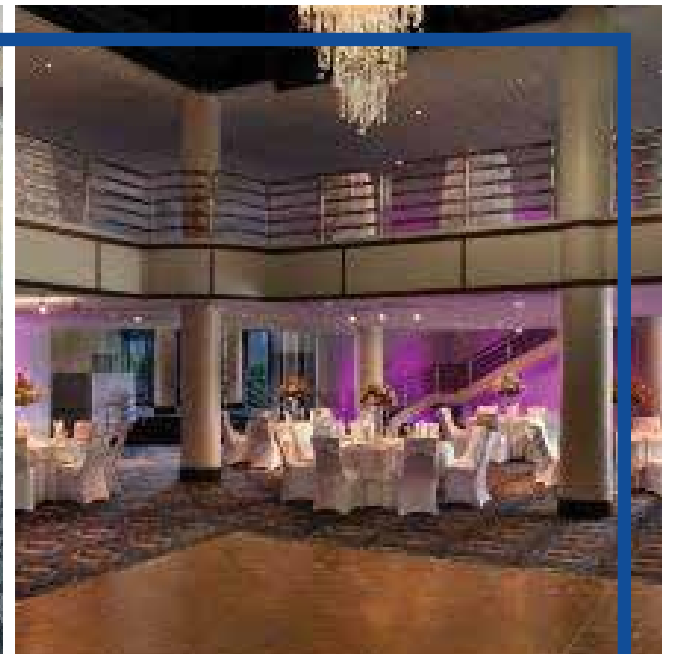
