Letter from the Founders

Dear Long Island Fight for Charity Supporters and Fans,

As the founders of the Long Island Fight for Charity, we (Jamie Austin, Matt Silver and Jeff Cohen) have never been more grateful for each and every supporter of the Long Island Fight for Charity (LIFFC). 

In September, the 2019 volunteer boxers toured the Headquarters of Family Residences and Essential Enterprises (FREE), to learn about the non-profit organization which provides many, if not all, "life requirements" for more than 4,000 individuals with intellectual/developmental disabilities, mental illness and traumatic brain injury. The boxers were treated to a special performance by the awardwinning FREE Players Ensemble and FREE's Drum Corps. Prior to the performance, the boxers demonstrated the boxing skills they have learned while training for the Fight for Charity.

"The 2019 Charity Boxers visit to FREE was an emotional day for all," said Jeff "The Founder" Cohen, of the Long Island Fight for Charity. "Each boxer had a chance to meet and interact firsthand with some of the people and programs they help support through the Long Island Fight for Charity. This day has always been one of my favorites throughout the year. It's inspiring and heartwarming to watch everyone talk, find common ground, hug and high-five. After the visit, if they didn't already, each boxer definitely knows what they are fighting for."

"Getting to spend time with the folks at FREE after their performance was an unbelievable opportunity for which I am grateful," said volunteer boxer Jenna "Breaking News" Macri.

"Learning about their lives, interests, and their experiences at FREE, while sharing our passions with each other, justified all the hours I have spent training and fundraising. I now know who and what I'm fighting for. I'm fighting for the girl who was ecstatic to put on my boxing gloves and show off her punching skills. I'm fighting for the young man who learned how to play the drums despite the difficulties he encounters. I'm fighting for the woman who shared the same music interests as me, and her friend whose speaking voice was barely above a whisper, but whose singing voice echoed throughout the gymnasium, absolutely wonderful, I will never forget this day."

"Seeing the smiles and pride on the faces of the program participants at FREE while they performed was motivating to say the least. Each of these people shared their gifts and talents with us today and it was beautiful. I am so proud to be a part of something so wonderful. If I learned anything today, it's that I need to work even harder to raise money. FREE, and the programs it provides, are a crucial part of lives of those who need them," said 2019 volunteer boxer Alden "The Incredible Hach" Peffer.









After knee replacement surgery, Adam Schwam had two goals: get back into shape and do it in a way to help others. In 2004, Schwam was a volunteer boxer in the Long Island Fight for Charity. His recovery from surgery gave him the motivation to come out of "retirement" and step into the ring with friend Bert Lurch, who had never boxed before. The journey the two have taken together is one neither man will forget.

Ask any Fight for Charity volunteer boxer about their experience as part of the Long Island Fight for Charity and training they will say it was amazing and one of the best experiences of their lives. Most will also say that the motion picture "Rocky" and its iconic music inspired them as well. For Schwam the best picture winner from 1976 isn't just a favorite, it's an obsession. This obsession was taken a step further with the production of the short film "What are a Few Punches Worth?" based on the blockbuster Stallone movie series.

From the film "What are a Few Punches Worth?" it is winter and Schwam is out in a wooded area on North Shore of Long Island, black knit hat pulled low over

his brow. He is sporting a brown bomber jacket with outturned collar lined with white fleece, doing his best to pull off the iconic look from Rocky IV. In the scene Schwam is training in the desolate wilderness using nothing but natural methods, iust like Balboa in the film. Schwam runs and reaches a clearing and calls out his nemesis' name "Bert!" instead of "Drago!"

"Training and the film were my way of doing something different and fun. I wanted to push myself and be creative. While the Apollo character and Rocky were rivals in the beginning, over the course of the films, they became friends. Bert and I are friends and going through the Fight for Charity experience has strengthened our relationship. What's great is that we are getting in awesome shape, having fun and helping others. We also have an entertaining movie that we can watch for years to come and use to motivate others," said Adam "The Hard Drive" Schwam, founder of Sandwire.

"Adam's a real friend and we both are members of the Long Island Elite organization that is supporting us. I was thinking of volunteering to box for a few years but it was Adam who convinced me




to do it," said Bert "The Collector" Lurch, CEO of E.Central Medical Management. "The whole Rocky-Apollo connection was intriguing and I knew we would have fun with it. The film trailers created a great buzz and we had an exciting film premiere event. I am sure that our bout at the Main Event will be memorable for all."


The film also featured appearances by Sal "The Hammer" Ferro one of the top fundraisers in Fight for Charity history who

The film's training montages for both Lurch and Schwam included a drone scene of them running on the beach. Schwam's version of the iconic Rocky stair running scene at the Philadelphia Museum of Art took place at the iconic stairs at the Jones Beach Water Tower. Schwam, like Rocky, is

The movie made its theatrical premiere in early November at Bellmore Movies and Showplace with over 150 supporters in attendance.



Anyone attending a Long Island Fight for Charity event - whether the Boxer **Announcement, Boxer** Matchup or the Main Event has been awe struck by the vocal performances of Ms. **Bridget Livingston. Bridget** is an inspiring individual and involved in activities that include being a vocal coach at Family Residences and **Essential Enterprises (FREE),** one of the three primary financial beneficiaries of the Fight for Charity. Bridget and Jeff "The Founder" Cohen go back more than 10 years when each worked at the agency.



How did you first become involved with FREE / LI Fight for Charity?

I started with FREE in 2008 due to an unforeseen change in my life's path. I was visiting a friend in church one Sunday. I had my eyes closed, and was praying for guidance on how I could come out of my situation. After the service, my friend asked me if I wanted a job, and gave me the address to an open house at FREE. Since then, I have never looked back. I began a wonderful job, working in an Amityville-based group home. I never knew there was a job like this. Shortly after starting, I realized that working at FREE released me from the burden of my own worries and allowed my heart to open up, care about and focus on the needs of others affording me the opportunity to experience true joy. Becoming a member of the FREE family fulfilled me in ways that words cannot express.

Then, one night, I attended FREE's production of "Into the Woods." Although a beautiful production, there where elements missing such as live vocals which grabbed my attention. I instantly knew in my heart that there could and should be more talent brought to these types of shows. So, I suggested to them that others might enjoy the opportunity to find and/or develop their voices and talents. In 2010 I started the FREE Players Ensemble through support of both my director and the agency's leadership.

After a very short time, it was clear that the members of the ensemble wanted to be seen and heard as the talented artists they absolutely were.

To date, the Players
Ensemble has performed for a
number of local functions, political
events and fundraisers. Notably,
they were the first differentlyabled group to sing the National
Anthem at the newly renovated
Nassau Veterans Memorial
Coliseum and Citi Field – both
historic events. That said,
these opportunities are just the
beginning for these very talented,
wonderful people.

How long have you been a singer and how did your talent come to be known?

My dad used to stand me on the dresser and we would sing together. One Easter Sunday at church, they called me to the front to sing. At first, I was nervous for a few reasons. There were so many people, I just didn't know what to expect and, what if I was not good enough to sing in front of all those people? My dad, on the other hand, encouraged and supported me and the next thing I knew, people were shouting, cheering and even tearing up with joy. Although shocked, it made me feel so good that I could bring joy to others through a God-given gift.

What has your experience been like singing at the LIFFC events and seeing and being present at them?

It's been a thrilling and humbling yet surprising experience to be a part of something that is so worthwhile and fulfilling for so many people. Knowing that so many people benefit from the Fight for Charity and that I am a part of the team, is mind blowing for me.

What do you most want others to know about LIFFC and the organizations/ charities which it supports?

I want people to know that even in their darkest moments, there are people out there who genuinely care. There is always a way, and LIFFC is one of the charities that is truly and directly making a difference in people's lives. They restored my belief that there are people out there who

What is your best memory/ experience since becoming involved in LIFFC?

A funny memory was sitting on the podium between Michael and Leon Spinks – sitting next to two world champions. Leon was trying to be funny, and I told him I was going to give him a TKO (laughs).

Is there anything else you want readers to know about you and your experience?

I want to thank everyone who played a part in helping me get from where I was to where I am now, which is looking forward to the future.

FFC Co-founder Matt Silver introduced Dominick to Fight for Charity and its goals.


Dominick is a member of BNI, LeTip, 516 Ads and the Farmingdale Chamber of Commerce.


His charity work includes Voices for Truth and Humanity.
